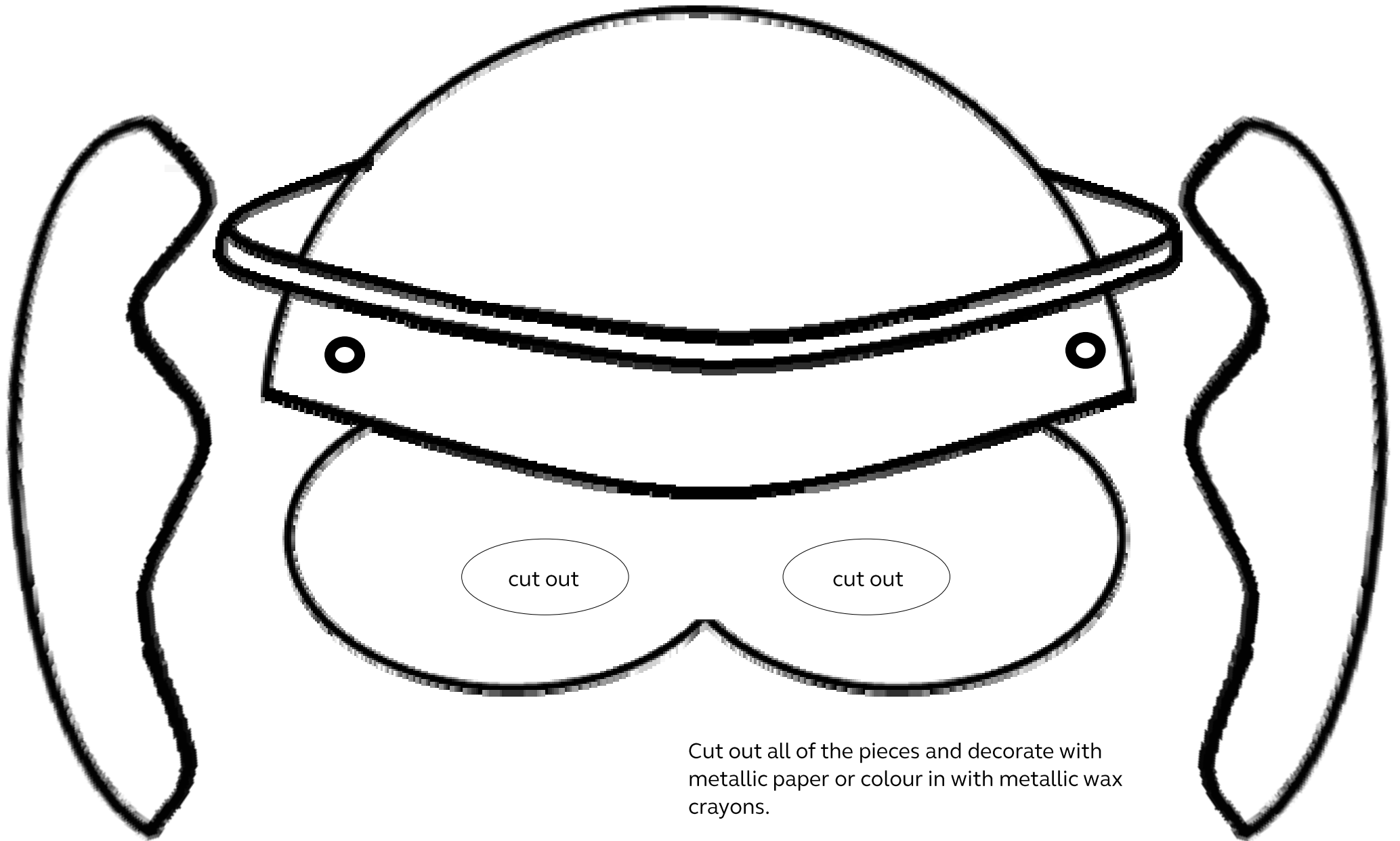
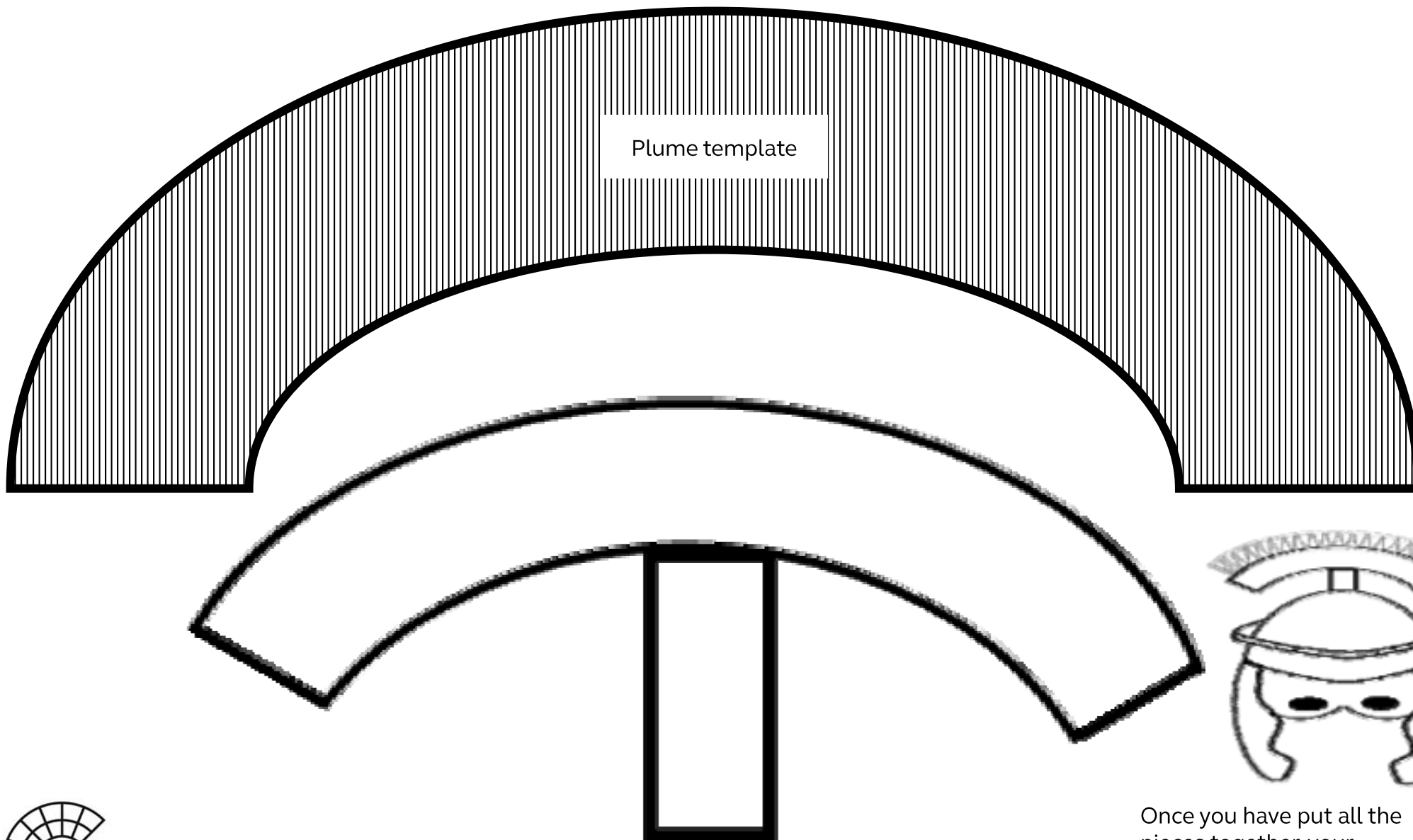


Roman Centurion Mask



Cut out all of the pieces and decorate with metallic paper or colour in with metallic wax crayons.

Cut out the shape below and use as a template for the plume at the top of the helmet. In Roman times the plume would have been made from horsehair...but coloured paper will do nicely, or you could wrap it in wool!



Once you have put all the pieces together, your centurion mask should look like this.
