

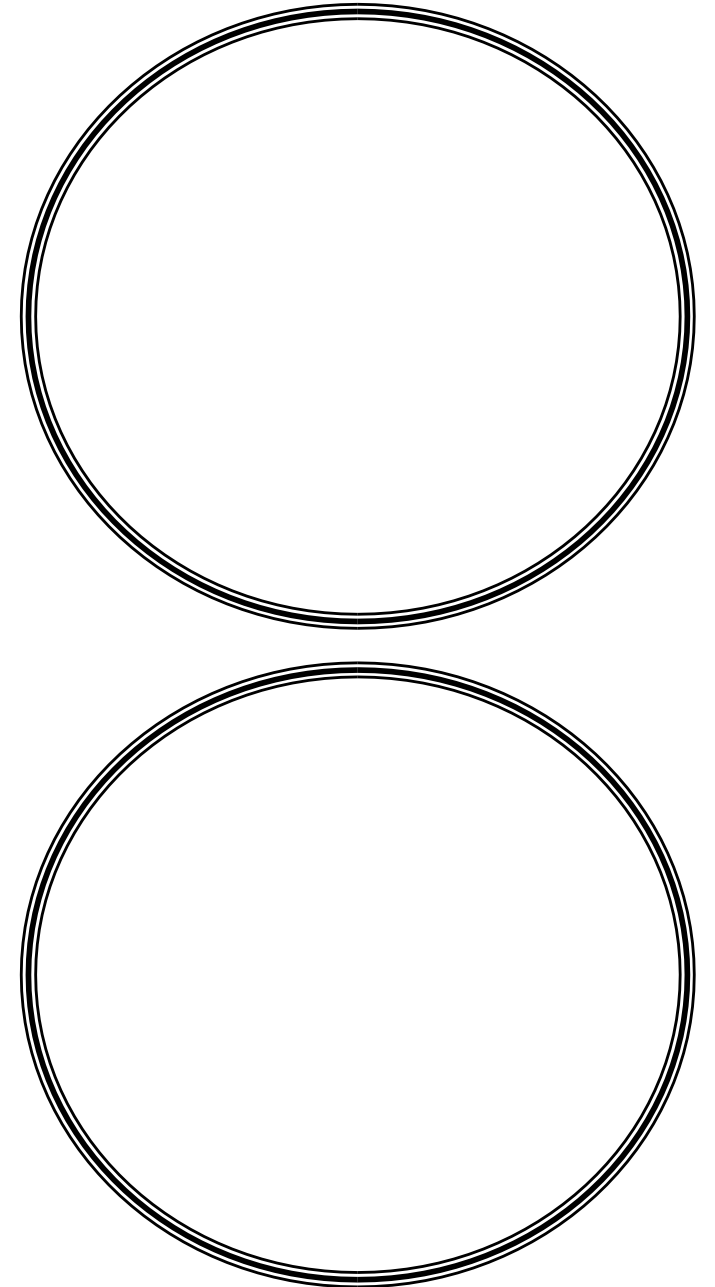
Create an Iron Age coin

Iron age coins were not poured into a mould. A blank coin was placed into a template, and struck with a heavy hammer so the pattern was embossed into the metal. One side showed the head of a tribal leader, and the other side displayed an Iron Age symbol, such as the Three Tailed Horse.
