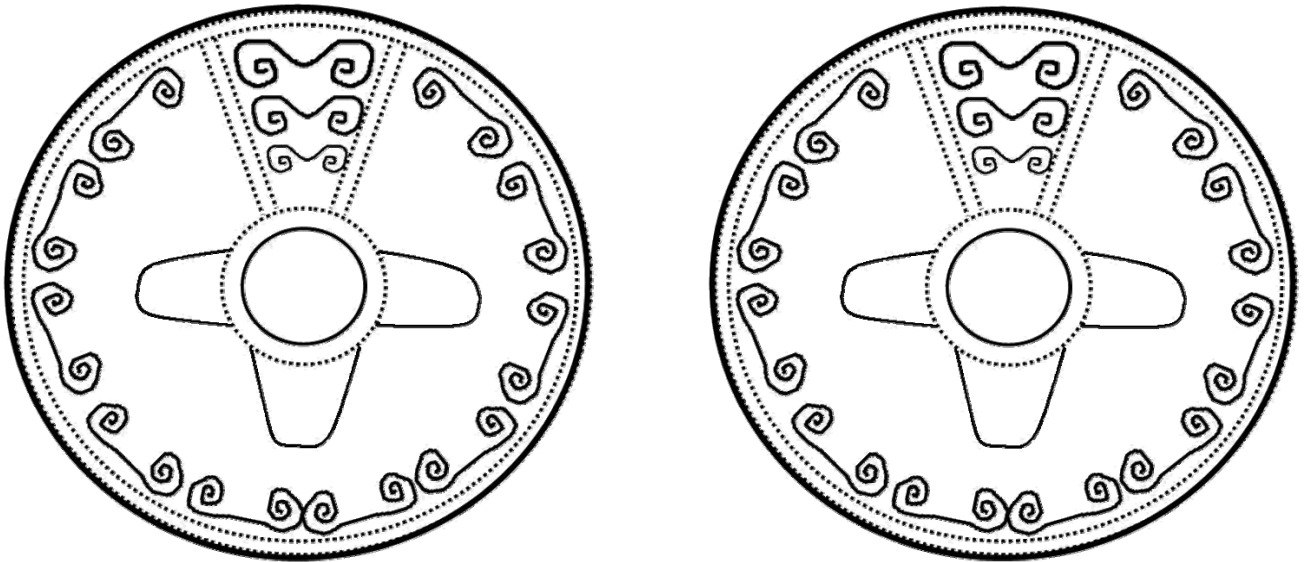


Anglo Saxon Brooch

The Anglo Saxons wore big bold brooches. They were skilled craftspeople who made beautiful jewellery using gold and semi-precious stones.



You will need

- Craft bits & bobs - pasta, pipe cleaners, dry beans, beads. These items will create the 'relief' on your brooch, and will be painted over, so it doesn't matter what colour they are.
- Shiny paper or foil
- Tape
- PVA glue
- Scissors
- Card
- 2 large safety pins
- Paint

To make your brooch

- Cut out two large circles from the cardboard about the size of the circles above. These are the base for your brooches
- Decorate your brooch with craft bits & bobs using PVA glue. You can use the above templates as a guide, or you can create your own patterns. Allow to dry
- Paint the entire brooch and allow to dry
- Glue any 'jewels' (shiny paper or foil) onto the brooch to finish
- Attach the safety pin with tape onto the back, pin onto clothing, and enjoy!
