## WALK OR CYCLE

**Walking routes:** Safe and scenic walking paths are available from the Market Square, through the Abbey Grounds, and from the Old Station and Sheep Street car parks.

**Cycling:** There are cycle racks in The Forum, the Leisure Centre, Beeches and the Old Station car parks. There are cycle lanes along Tetbury Road and through the Abbey Grounds, making getting to the Corinium Museum safer for you.



## PUBLIC TRANSPORT

**Bus routes:** There are several bus stops in Cirencester town centre near to the Corinium Museum, with bus services available from the surrounding areas and towns.
